

Visiting Assistant Professor in Mathematics - 2 positions

The Department of Mathematics and Computer Science at Ashland University invites applications for two one-year Visiting Assistant Professor positions in Mathematics, beginning August 2010. Ashland University is a private, comprehensive, liberal arts and sciences institution serving 2,000 students at the main campus in Ashland, Ohio. The Mathematics program offers both a major and minor in Mathematics, a major in Actuarial Science, and a B.S. in Education with a major in Integrated Mathematics. The Department also provides courses in support of the University Core Curriculum and other undergraduate majors.

The candidate for the first position will primarily teach mathematics content courses for prospective teachers (elementary, middle grades, secondary), while the candidate for the second position will teach elementary statistics and other mathematics courses.

For both positions, a masters degree in Mathematics or Mathematics Education is required (PhD preferred) along with teaching experience with demonstrated excellence. A complete application will include letter of application, current vita, statement on teaching philosophy, copies of graduate transcripts, and three letters of reference.
