

## Assistant Professor of Mathematics

The Department of Mathematics at Saint Xavier University invites applications for a one year, temporary full-time faculty appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor and seeks a person with expertise in mathematics education and mathematics. Primary responsibilities include teaching mathematics content courses for elementary education majors and students seeking middle level mathematics endorsement, and supervision of mathematics student teachers at the secondary level. Ability to teach courses in the mathematics major is also highly desirable. Preference will be given to candidates with (i) a Ph.D. in Mathematics Education with extensive graduate coursework in mathematics or (ii) a Ph.D. in Mathematics with extensive mathematics education course work. The strongest candidates will also have teaching experience at the middle or secondary school level and certification. This is a temporary replacement appointment for a tenure track position for which we expect to conduct a national search during 2010-11. Applicants should submit a cover letter, curriculum vitae, transcripts, and three letters of recommendation, one of which should address experience teaching mathematics to prospective elementary teachers.
