The new faculty member will join a collaborative group of twelve faculty including three mathematics educators. The successful candidate will be expected to teach 9 to 12 contact hours per semester to undergraduate and graduate students. Primarily, the position involves working with mathematics content courses for teachers. Other duties will include service activities, both internal and external to campus, and developing partnerships with K-12 mathematics. We seek an individual with expertise in teaching diverse learners and/or integrating technology with instruction.

- Doctorate in Mathematics Education, Mathematics, or related field with the equivalent of a Master's degree in a mathematical field
- Demonstrated ability to collaborate with colleagues
- Excellent interpersonal, verbal and written communication skills

- Evidence of scholarly potential
- Experience working with diverse student populations
- Experience implementing instruction with mathematical manipulatives and technological resources
- University-level teaching experience using student-centered learning strategies
- Experience teaching undergraduate mathematics to wide audiences
