## ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF MATHEMATICS EDUCATION

**Position:** Applications are being solicited for an assistant professor of mathematics education to begin in August 2010. The position is a tenure-track, academic year appointment with the possibility of summer employment.

**Qualifications:** A doctorate in mathematics education or related field is required (and must be earned by the start date), and graduate-level study in mathematics is expected. An active record of scholarship and productivity commensurate with experience is required. The successful candidate should have strong potential for or a proven track record in attracting external funding. School mathematics teaching experience is expected.

**Responsibilities:** Primary responsibilities for research include conducting an active research program in mathematics education, publishing scholarly work, and seeking external funding. Primary responsibilities for teaching include courses in undergraduate mathematics education programs for elementary, middle, or secondary school teachers; courses in graduate mathematics teacher education programs; courses in the mathematics education doctoral program; and advisement of undergraduate and graduate students. **Procedure:** Submit a letter of application, curriculum vita, transcripts for all degrees earned (unofficial transcripts accepted initially), a statement of professional goals, a sample of published scholarly writing, and three letters of reference to Denise S. The application deadline is **March 10, 2010**, but we will continue to receive and screen applications until the position is filled. Note that we currently have 3 positions open (2 temporary assistant professors and this tenure-track position), so please be sure to specify clearly the position(s) for which you are applying. Please clearly indicate if you are interested in the temporary positions if you apply for the tenure track position, and we will use the same application materials for both searches.

**Local context:** The University of Georgia Department of Mathematics and Science Education consists of 11 full-time mathematics educators and 8 full-time science educators with research interests spanning learning, curriculum, teaching, teacher education, technology, and equity. In the mathematics education program we offer BSEd, MEd, MA, MAT, EdS, and PhD degrees and support over 30 mathematics education doctoral students with assistantships. We currently have multiple active NSF grants, including the Center for Proficiency in Teaching Mathematics. We enjoy strong collaborative relationships with colleagues in the Mathematics Department, the Statistics Department, and area school districts. The College of Education consists of 9 departments and approximately 220 faculty members. The University of Georgia is a land- and sea-grant research-intensive university composed of 15 schools and colleges with approximately 33,000 students. Athens is a town of approximately 100,000 located 75 miles northeast of Atlanta.
